- The manuscript is prepared within the guidelines presented here.
- The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided to the Editor of this proceeding.
- The submission file is in Microsoft Word or OpenOffice document file format and prepared using the LUMAT template.
- The text employs italics rather than underlining (except with URL addresses), and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points rather than at the end.
- Include DOIs for all possible references.
- I have included authors' names and affiliations in the manuscript.
- If possible, add ORCID iDs for all authors.
- I understand that all manuscripts will be sent to the Urkund similarity check.

## **Author Guidelines**

#### Preparing Manuscript for the MAVI Freiburg conference

LUMAT publishes peer-reviewed scientific publications in the fields of mathematics, science, and technology education. Before submitting your manuscript for the conference. Please go through the text and align it with the guidelines below.

#### Language

The language of the manuscript is British English.

#### Format

The paper should be submitted as a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx) or OpenDocument Text file (.odt). Please use the template that is provided by the Freiburg team and follow the guidelines in the formatting of the text:

**Length:** Ten-page limit; do not send in papers that are longer.

Title: Use the sentence case capitalisation.

Abstract: Maximum of 250 words.

Keywords: 3–5 relevant keywords

**Headings:** Use the sentence case capitalisation and numbered heading levels (1, 1.1, 1.1.1, 2...)

**Text, charts, images and tables** must be included in the manuscript. Please use sentence case writing.

**References and citing** according to <u>APA 7 style</u> using automatic citation management tools. The usage of automatic tools is mandatory.

**Template:** Use the template that is provided by the Freiburg team. This is mandatory.

### Files to be Submitted

Your submission should include a pre-conference version.

#### Licence

When submitting the paper, the authors grant permission for it to be published in journal *LUMAT: International Journal on Math, Science and Technology Education* and allow others to copy and distribute the article under Creative Commons Attribution (<u>CC</u> <u>BY 4.0</u>) copyright license. The authors are responsible for their text and have a copyright on it. All submitted manuscripts will go through the Urkund similarity check.
