Health Insurance

International students who participate in a study abroad programme must have a valid health insurance certificate in order to be enrolled at the University of Education Freiburg. Students from any of the Nordic and EEA/EU countries have access to public medical services if they bring a confirmation of their affiliation to a Social Security Insurance in their home countries (European Health Insurance Card or E111). Non-EEA/EU-citizens should contact their local social insurance office before departure to Germany. We recommend to get your student health insurance in Germany.
